

Otoplasty


For protruding, asymmetrical, or misshapen ears.

What is otoplasty?

Otoplasty, or ear surgery, is most commonly performed to set prominent ears back closer to the head. Ear surgery is also performed to reduce the size of overly large or misshapen ears, as well as to correct asymmetry.

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Who is a good candidate for otoplasty?

At about 6 years of age, ears have reached their approximate adult size, making children from 6-14 years old the most common candidates for otoplasty. It is not uncommon, though, for an adult to undergo the procedure. Children with prominent ears often become aware they look “different” once they begin going to school and they are often teased by their peers, causing anxiety and self-esteem issues. Both children and adults who have protruding or overly large ears find immense satisfaction after undergoing this simple surgical procedure.

What can I expect after surgery?

Otoplasty usually takes 1 hour to complete. After surgery, the ears will be wrapped with bandages to assist in the molding and healing. Patients are able to resume a fairly normal schedule 3-5 days later.

What is the first step?

If considering otoplasty for yourself or for your child, the first step is a consultation with a board certified facial plastic surgeon. During a consultation Dr. Dayan will examine the structure of the ears and discuss the patient’s goals and concerns.
