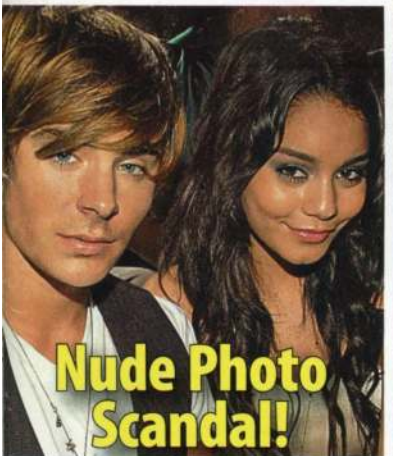

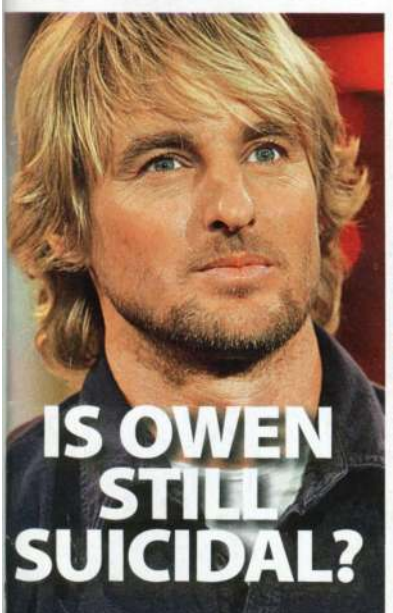

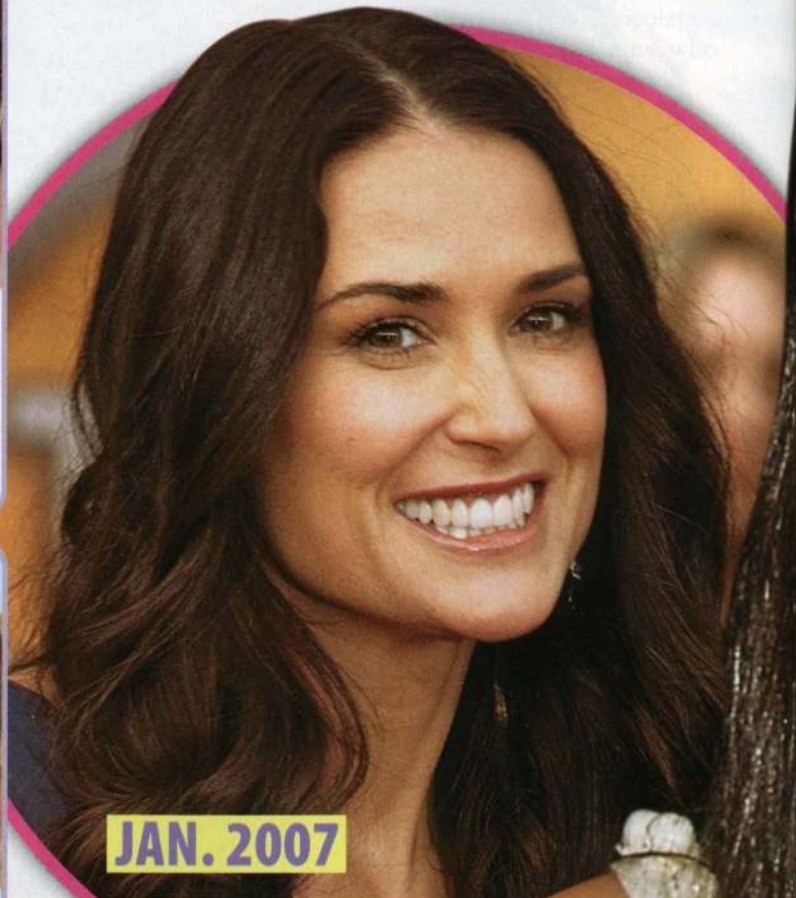

Botox, Dr. Dayan notes that "minimal expression lines in her forehead" are consistent with a bit of help from the age-reversing agent.

There's a reason people can now actually *show* their excitement about Botox! Thanks to better injection placement, "the days of the frozen face are pretty much gone," says Chicago plastic surgeon Dr. Steven Dayan about treatment (up to \$550 per area). But it can take trial and

error to get perfect results (which last up to six months). "When done just right, muscles are relaxed, not frozen," says Bal Harbour, Fla., plastic surgeon Dr. Michael Salzhauer. "But not everyone reacts the same to a given amount." What *do* Botox users have in common? Years off their face!

A youthful-looking Demi Moore, 44, didn't appear to have a single line — even when she flashed a wide, radiant smile at NYC's Fashion Week on Sept. 4. But "she has a mildly frozen look," Dr. Salzhauer says about Demi's "super-smooth" forehead and vanished crow's-feet, likely the result of a dose of Botox.

Can Teri bring her brows back down?

These days, Teri Hatcher, 42, seems a bit *too* uplifted! "She may have too much Botox in the center of her forehead and not

enough on the sides," Dr. Salzhauer notes about Teri's likely uneven fill. The result? Overarched — and raised — eyebrows.

Breaking news: Can Botox improve skin?

Botox, known as an antiaging serum, may now be a beautifying potion as well. MesoBotox, a new technique that entails injecting tiny amounts of the wonder drug into skin (not muscles), removes fine lines, decreases oil production (just as Botox can eliminate sweating and acne) and possibly minimizes pore size. While it's not FDA-approved yet, Dr. Dayan says MesoBotox would likely cost only up to \$1,200 for the entire face. Sounds like a smooth idea!
